To make your gift worth an extra 28% to us, without costing you any more, please complete the form below so we can recover this amount from HM Revenue & Customs.

- ~ You can cancel this declaration any time by notifying us
- ~ You must pay an amount of income and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax the charity reclaims on your donation in the tax year (currently 28p for each £1 that you give)
- ~ If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that the charity reclaims, you should cancel this declaration
- ~ If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further relief on your Self Assessment Tax Return
- ~ If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid relief, ask us. Or ask your local tax office for leaflet IR113 *Gift Aid*
