We are looking for volunteers to become regular volunteers at our Teenage Cancer Trust challenge events. We need volunteer support at our challenge events to encourage, support and guide our participants. Our Challenge Events are an incredible source of fundraising for the charity. Over 4,500 of our amazing supporters run, cycle, climb mountains, jump out of planes, scale buildings and tackle mud, fire and ice every year, raising over £2million to help young people with cancer.

We are looking for Challenge Volunteers in the following roles

- **Cheer Squad members**
 - Can cheer, whoop and clap along our amazing team of Teenage Cancer Trust participants and your support will help our runners to stay motivated throughout their challenge, and ultimately help Teenage Cancer Trust to achieve our goal of reaching every young person diagnosed with cancer.
- **Event Support Volunteers**
 - Assist at the finish line of one of our challenge events as our amazing Teenage Cancer Trust participants complete their challenge. At the finish line area, you will be needed to help us ensure that things run smoothly and that our participants are congratulated after completing their incredible challenge!
- **Massage Therapists**
 - We are looking for professional Volunteer Massage Therapists to help our challenge participants to recover after their gruelling challenge! You will be required to have the qualifications in massage therapy and your own Professional Indemnity Insurance
