### About the event:

Zip Wire for Stephen is in memory of Teenage Cancer Trust ambassador and fundraiser Stephen Sutton, who passed away five years ago this May. The event is the brainchild of Jane Sutton, Stephen's mum and Teenage Cancer Trust ambassador, who has committed to continuing Stephen's work since his death.

Stephen's Story has raised a staggering £5.7 million for Teenage Cancer Trust to date. Zip Wire for Stephen, held at Zip World Penrhyn Quarry, will help Stephen's Story reach its next major fundraising milestone of £6 million.

- Ideally, you'll be a professional or talented amateur photographer, or a photography student looking to develop your portfolio
- The ability to build rapport with supporters and young people with cancer
- An understanding of photography and some good experience of this type of work
- Creativity and initiative to take the best possible shots
- Ability to take direction where necessary, particularly when working with vulnerable young people
